### FIRST AND TEN

• Saturday's contest against Tulane will close out ULM's slate for September as well as its non-conference schedule... The Warhawks are currently 2-1 in the month of September with wins over Grambling State (home) and Wake Forest (away) and most recently a loss to No. 19 Baylor (away).

• ULM and Tulane are meeting on the gridiron for the second consecutive season... Last season, the Warhawks claimed a 63-10 win over the Green Wave in New Orleans to earn its first win in the all-time series... ULM dropped the two previous meetings to the Green Wave (L, 9-52, Oct. 5, 2002, Monroe; L, 10-24, Sept. 20, 2008, New Orleans).

• Tulane's trip to Malone Stadium Saturday will be the second trip all-time for the Green Wave... Tulane's only other trip to ULM was on Oct. 5, 2002 as the visitors earned a win in the first-ever meeting between the two clubs.

• Against teams currently in Conference USA, the Warhawks own a 52-64 all-time record (.448 win pct.).

• So far this season, the Sun Belt Conference is 3-0 against Conference USA (Week 1 - Texas State def. Southern Miss; Troy def. UAB; Week 2 - South Alabama def. Tulane).

• Following Saturday's contest against Tulane, ULM will have a short turnaround as they welcome Western Kentucky for a Thursday night contest (Oct. 3, ESPN3)... It will be the first of two occurrences this season where the Warhawks play on Saturday and then play the following Thursday (Oct. 26, Georgia State; Oct. 31, at Troy (ESPN3)).

• With 262 yards of total offense at No. 19 Baylor, Kolton Browning became ULM's all-time leader in total offense as he passed Steven Jyles (2002-05)... Browning currently has 10,323 yards of total offense -- 8,917 passing, 1,406 rushing... Jyles totaled 10,234 yards of total offense during his four-year career (8,987 passing, 1,247 rushing).

• Kolton Browning is closing in on three other program records... The Mabank, Texas native needs 19 total plays to become the program's all-time leader, he needs 71 passing yards to take over the top spot and he needs 76 passing attempts to become the career leader.

• Jyruss Edwards needs 26 rushing yards to pass Lloyd Ray Smith for sixth all-time... Edwards currently has 1,713 rushing yards... Smith rushed for 1,738 yards from 1953-1958.

• Tavares Maye moved into the top five in program history after making five catches at No. 19 Baylor... Maye currently has 169 receptions and he passed Darrell McNeal's (2006-09) and Stepfret Williams' (1992-95) mark of 168 career grabs.

• At No. 19 Baylor, Isaiah Newsome recorded his first interception of the season and the eighth of his career in the third quarter... It was the second interception of the season for the Warhawk defense (Cordero Smith, at Oklahoma)... The interception thrown by Baylor QB Seth Russell was the first interception thrown this season by the Bears.

• Hunter Kissinger led the Warhawk defense as he tied a career-high with six total tackles (four solo, two asst)... It was the third time in his Warhawk career that he tallied six tackles in a single game -- most recently at Arkansas State (Nov. 8, 2012).

• Austin Moss set a new career-high with four total tackles (two solo, two asst)... His previous career-best was three tackles (at No. 16 Oklahoma, Aug. 31, 2013).

• Lorenzo Jackson, like Kissinger and Moss, also set a new career-high with three tackles at Baylor.

• Cortney Davis continued his climb up the charts as he now has 1,000 career kick return yards, placing him seventh in ULM history.

• Justin Manton recorded a 77-yard punt in the third quarter, which was a career-long for the junior... His 77-yard boot is tied for second in program history (John Kelly, 77 yards, at McNeese State, 1962)... Manton finished the game with nine punts for 479 yards (53.2 avg), with three touchbacks and one inside the 20... He also kicked off twice for 130 yards (65.0 avg) and two touchbacks.

## #ULMvsTulaneSeries

The two Louisiana schools will meet for just the fourth time ever when they battle Saturday night at Malone Stadium... Tulane won the first two meetings in the series (W, 52-9, Oct. 5, 2002, Malone Stadium; W, 24-10, Sept. 20, 2008, New Orleans)... Last season, the Warhawks picked up a 63-10 win in New Orleans for their first victory in the series (Sept. 29, 2012).

## #2012Rewind

**NEW ORLEANS** -- It was ULM early and often on Saturday afternoon as the Warhawks cruised to a 63-10 win at Tulane inside the Mercedes-Benz Superdome. Junior quarterback Kolton Browning led the charge as he went 15-for-21 for 253 yards and three touchdowns, including a long strike of 52 yards. With his performance, Browning surpassed 6,000 career passing yards and 1,000 season passing yards.

The ULM defense scored twice, once on a Darius Lively interception and again on a R.J. Young interception that was recovered by Ray Stovall in the endzone for the score. It held Tulane to 151 total yards and 11 first downs.

Jyruss Edwards rushed 11 times for 56 yards and two touchdowns to move into a tie for fifth with Joe Profit with 19 career-rushing touchdowns. DeVontae McNeal finished with 114 yards on 10 carries and one touchdown. ULM rushed for 222 yards while Tulane finished with -9 yards on the ground. Je'Ron Hamm caught three balls for 86 yards and a touchdown to lead the ULM receiving corps. The ULM offense totaled 553 yards.

## #ScoutingTheGreenWave

Tulane enters the final weekend of September with a 2-2 record overall and a 1-0 mark in league play... The club has alternated wins and losses over the first four weeks of the season... The Green Wave opened the season with a 34-7 victory over Jackson State... Tulane lost in week two to Sun Belt Conference member South Alabama, 41-39, before defeating Louisiana Tech in its C-USA opener (W, 24-15)... Last weekend, Tulane fell on the road at Syracuse by a score of 52-17.

Nick Montana has taken the majority of snaps under center and the junior is 77-of-153 for 919 yards with eight touchdowns and three interceptions... Rob Kelley and Orleans Darkwa lead the Green Wave rushing attack as the duo has combined for 381 rushing yards and six touchdowns... Ryan Grant is the only wide receiver with more than 10 grabs this season... Grant has caught 31 passes for 418 yards and three scores... Justyn Shackelford is second on the team with nine receptions for 149 yards and like Grant, he has three touchdown receptions.

Sam Scofield is Tulane's leading tackler with 29 total tackles (22 solo, 7 asst), including four tackles for loss... Darion Monroe and Nico Marley are tied for second with 24 total tackles this season... Marley is also one of six Tulane players to record an interception this season... The Green Wave defensive unit has totaled 29 tackles for loss and six tackles while recording 11 turnovers (seven interceptions, four fumbles).

## #AgainstC-USA

ULM owns a 52-64 record (.448 win pct) against teams that are current members of Conference USA... ULM is 7-2 against Florida Atlantic, 6-3% against FIU (FIU's 2005 win was later vacated by the NCAA), 14-29 against Louisiana Tech, 1-0 against Marshall, 4-9 against Middle Tennessee, 16-13 against North Texas, 1-3 against Southern Mississippi, 1-2 against Tulane, 1-2 against Tulsa and 1-1 against UAB.

## #NewOrleansFunFacts

Below are 10 things you may or may not know about the city of New Orleans:

- New Orleans was founded in 1718 by Jean Baptiste Le Moyne and the original community still exists as the French Quarter.
- New Orleans has twice been the capital of Louisiana, first from 1812-1825 and again from 1864-1879.
- The Mercedes-Benz Superdome was the largest dome in the world from 1975-1992.
- The New Orleans Saints won Louisiana's lone professional sports championship, defeating the Indianapolis Colts 31-17 in Super Bowl XLIV.
- New Orleans is the largest city in Louisiana based on population, with 369,250 people.
- New Orleans is called the "Crescent City" because of the crescent-shaped bend that it forms along the Mississippi River.
- The Lake Pontchartrain Causeway is the longest continuous bridge over water in the world, measuring just under 24 miles long.
- New Orleans was the largest city in the Confederacy during the Civil War, more than four times the size of Charleston, S.C., the second-largest city.
- The first opera in the United States was performed in New Orleans in 1796.
- Poker was invented in New Orleans in 1829.

## #HallOfFameWeekend

ULM will induct three new members into its hall of fame this weekend... The 2013 class includes Bobby Craighead (football), Randall Walker (track) and Larry Carr (basketball)... Induction festivities take place at 10 a.m. on the seventh floor of the ULM library.

### BOBBY CRAIGHEAD (1980- 83)

Name is peppered in the football record books for rushing, receiving and scoring. He is the only player in program history to record three catches of 50 or more yards in a single game. Also holds four slots in category of receptions of 60 or more yards and ranks third in history with 222 receiving yards against Southeastern Louisiana (1981). He was named all-conference in 1982 (tight end) and 1983 (running back), while earning All-Louisiana honors (running back) in his final season.

### LARRY CARR (1993-95)

A member of the men's basketball team from 1993-1995. During his career he was named Southland Conference Newcomer of the Year, First Team Southland Conference, All-Louisiana Newcomer of the Year and First Team All-Louisiana. He also participated in the NCAA Slam Dunk Competition, finishing third overall. Carr finished career with 1,030 career points and ranks in the top 10 in five different categories. Following career, he played professionally in Slovakia, Venezuela, Puerto Rico, Hungary and Cypress. He returned to ULM to finish his degree and received his BA degree in 2009.

### RANDALL WALKER (1960-63)

Walker earned a total of three conference championships in the 440-yard dash (1961, 1962 and 1963). He was undefeated for three consecutive seasons in the 440-yard dash. He also claimed conference championships in the high hurdles (1961 and 1963) and the mile relay (1961, 1962 and 1963). Posted five consecutive victories over LSU in the mile relay in 1963.

### Additional Information:

- Coach To Cure MD is supported by thousands of college coaches at all levels of college football.
- Duchenne muscular dystrophy is the most common fatal childhood genetic disorder -- it is a progressive muscle disorder that causes loss of muscle function and independence.
- The Duchenne gene is found on the X-chromosome so it primarily affects boys -- approximately one in every 3,500 live male births across all races and cultures.
- To date, there is no cure and life expectancy is just in the 20s.
- Research to find a cure is underway on many college campuses. Last year college fans helped Parent Project Muscular Dystrophy award grants to Ohio State, UCLA, Florida and Missouri (among others), to help support muscle research.

## #ThreeStraight

ULM tight end Harley Scioneaux recorded his third touchdown grab of the season in Saturday's loss at Baylor... The sophomore has recorded one touchdown reception in each of the last three games and now has six career touchdown receptions.

## #CareerBoot

ULM punter Justin Manton recorded a career-long 77-yard punt in ULM's road contest at Baylor... His booming third-quarter punt is tied for the second longest punt in ULM history... He is tied with John Kelly who had a 77-yard punt at McNeese State on Oct. 13, 1962... Chick Childress holds the ULM record with an 88-yard punt (at Western Kentucky, 1952).

Manton also recorded a 69-yard punt in the fourth-quarter at Baylor, which places him in a tied for eighth-place in program history... In all, Manton punted nine times for 479 yards (53.2 avg) with five punts of 50 or more yards, three touchbacks, one inside the 20... He also kicked off twice for 130 yards (65.0 avg) and two touchbacks... Manton was named one of College Football Performance Awards' Honorable Mention Punters of the Week (Sept. 23).

## #LetItFly

Kolton Browning's 68 passing attempts at Wake Forest are the second-most in a single game, while his 43 completions are tied for third nationally in a single game... Only Derek Carr (Fresno State; 73) has more single game passing attempts than Browning this season... Carr also recorded 52 completions earlier this season, while Shane Carden (East Carolina) ranks second with 46... Browning is tied for third nationally with Texas Tech's Baker Mayfield with 43 completions in a game.

## #SunBeltOffensivePOW

After setting single-game career-highs in both completions (43) and attempts (68) in ULM's 21-19 win at Wake Forest, senior quarterback Kolton Browning was named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16, 2013.

Midway through the second quarter, Browning connected with Je'Ron Hamm for his school-record 796th career completion... Browning took the top spot in the ULM record book as he passed Steven Jyles who tallied 795 career completions from 2002-05.

Browning ended the game with 827 career completions after finishing 43-of-68 for 315 yards and three touchdowns. The Mabank, Texas native found Harley Scioneaux, Kenzee Jackson and Tavarese Maye for the three Warhawk scores... Browning also rushed nine times for 19 yards in ULM's first-ever win over an ACC program.

**#ThirdDownSuccess**

ULM faced 28 third-downs in its 21-19 win at Wake Forest and the Warhawks were able to convert on 15 of those (54%)... ULM's 15 third-down conversions were the most ever by a Wake Forest opponent (previous high 14 by North Carolina [1986] and Connecticut [2003])... The Warhawks' 28 attempts is also a Wake Forest opponent record, surpassing the old record of 24 set by Appalachian State (1981) and Boston University (1986).

**#EditingTheRecordBooks**

As a junior, ULM quarterback Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career touchdowns as he connected with Je'Ron Hamm against North Texas to pass Steven Jyles who had 55 touchdown passes from 2002-05... Browning finished his junior season with 60 career touch-down passes and now sits at 67 after four games during the 2013 season... He also became the program's all-time leader in total touchdowns against Grambling State... Browning entered the season tied with Jyles, but now holds the record with 83 career touchdowns (67 passing, 16 rushing)... The Mabank, Texas native has 844 career completions and at Wake Forest, he surpassed Steven Jyles (795; 2002-05) to become the all-time leader in ULM history... At Baylor, Browning passed Jyles in career yards of total offense -- Browning now ranks number one in program history with 10,323 yards of total offense (8,917 passing; 1,406 rushing)... Jyles amassed 10,234 yards of total offense during his career (8,987 passing; 1,247 rushing)... The next records in Browning's crosshairs are career passing yards, plays and passing attempts... Browning needs 71 passing yards to become the all-time leader, 76 passing attempts for the top spot and 19 plays for the career-record.

**#DavisToTheHouse**

In the home opener against Grambling State, Cortney Davis electrified the crowd of 23,600 at Malone Stadium as he returned the opening kickoff (89 yards) for a touchdown (first career return for a TD) to give ULM a 7-0 lead just 10 seconds into the contest... Davis' kickoff return for a score was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011... Davis returned another kickoff for 12 yards as he finished with 101 return yards and 103 all-purpose yards (two rushing yards)... Davis also earned Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week Honors from the College Football Performance Awards.

**#DualThreat**

ULM quarterback Kolton Browning is a dual-threat as the four-year starter has four career games of at least three passing touchdowns and at least one rushing touchdown... **#SixteenTackles**

Senior LB Cameron Blakes made his presence felt as he tallied 16 tackles, a new career-best, in the season opener at Oklahoma... His previous career-best came against Middle Tennessee in Monroe on Nov. 12, 2011... Blakes registered three tackles in the first quarter as he and the rest of the Warhawk defense kept the Sooners off of the scoreboard... At the half, Blakes had seven total tackles, before tallying seven tackles during the third quarter... He added two stops in the final quarter to finish with 16 tackles (nine solo, seven asst).

**#BerryBall**

Todd Berry is in his fourth season at the helm of the Warhawk program... Berry returned to Monroe in Dec. 2009 when he was named the program's 14th head coach... Last season, Berry guided ULM to an FBS-era best eight wins as the squad finished tied for second in the Sun Belt (6-2) and made its first appearance in a bowl game since moving up to the FBS ranks (1994-pres)... The Warhawks made the short trip west to Shreveport, La., as they battled the Bobcats of Ohio in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl.

The five others are: Logan Kilgore (Middle Tennessee); Taylor Martinez (Nebraska); Taylor McHargue (Rice); Aaron Murray (Georgia); Nathan Scheelchase (Illinois).

**#Reffett'sRegime**

In defensive coordinator Troy Reffett's 52 career games in charge of the defense, the Warhawks have forced 94 turnovers and at least one in 49 of the 53 contests... The attacking defense has also recorded 107 sacks and 292 tackles for loss -- at one point, ULM had a sack in 23 straight games under Reffett.

**#PutEmOnTheBoard**

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 131 of its 141 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... The squad was shutout in the 2013 season opener at Oklahoma, snapping a streak of 24 consecutive games of recording at least one score.

**#ULMGrads**

Two Warhawks have already received their undergraduate degrees while another seven are set to graduate in December... Madison Tharp and Preston Coleman already have their degrees and will be joined by Kolton Browning, Jyruss Edwards, Tavarese Maye, Austin Moss, Isaiah Newsome, Ray Stovall (junior) and Monterrell Washington following commencement in December... Those expected to graduate following the spring semester are Josh Allen, Cameron Blakes, Kentarius Caldwell, Emmanuel Jefferies and Roland Veal (junior).

**#HighDefinition**

The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

**#PartyLikelt's1999**

In last season's 63-10 win at Tulane, the Warhawk defense found the endzone on two different occasions... The two defensive scores marked the first time ULM had two or more touchdowns on the defensive side of the ball since the 1999 season... In 1999, ULM intercepted Northwestern State QB Brad Spangler three times and returned all three for touchdowns as ULM claimed a 38-7 win (Sept. 25).

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

**#FridayNightLights**

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.... The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team... The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

**#PowerOfEight**

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.

Buoyed by a powerful rushing attack that racked up 367 yards on the ground, including 123 by senior Jyruss Edwards, ULM earned a 48-10 victory over Grambling State on Saturday evening at Malone Stadium. ULM fell behind early on Saturday afternoon at Floyd Casey Stadium in Waco, Texas, dropping a 70-7 decision to No. 19 Baylor on the road. For the Warhawks, Kolton Browning went 17-of-41 for 219 yards and found Harley Scioneaux for a touchdown in the second quarter. Browning also rushed 10 times for 43 yards, showing off his scrambling abilities. ### POSTGAME NOTES

- ULM falls to 0-2 all-time against Baylor... The Warhawks fall to 0-10 all-time against teams currently in the Big 12 Conference.
- Kolton Browning completed 17 passes for 219 yards and one touchdown... Browning also led the team with 43 rushing yards (10 attempts).
- Harley Scioneaux's second quarter touchdown reception was the third of the season (and sixth career) for the sophomore... It also marks the third straight game that Scioneaux has recorded a TD reception.
- Isaiah Newsome recorded his first interception of the season (and eighth of his career) in the third quarter of Saturday's game... It was the second interception of the season for the Warhawk defense (Cordero Smith, at Oklahoma)... The interception thrown by Baylor QB Seth Russell was the first of the season by the Bears.
- Hunter Kissinger led the Warhawk defense with six total tackles (four solo, two asst).
- Justin Manton recorded a 77-yard punt in the third quarter, which was a career-long for the junior... His 77-yard boot is tied for second in program history (John Kelly, 77 yards, at McNeese State, 1962)... Manton finished the game with nine punts for 479 yards (53.2 avg).
