## CAMP DIRECTORS

### STACY LAMB

#### ULM HEAD WOMEN'S COACH

Stacy Lamb is beginning her tenth year as Head Coach of the ULM Soccer program. She was named both Southland Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year in 2001. A four-time All-Conference and All-Region player at Lees-McRae College in Banner Elk, NC. Lamb was selected as All-American three times and was voted Freshman of the Year in 1993. She holds school career records for goals, assists and total points. Lamb graduated in 1997 with a BS in English Literature and Communications. In 1999, she earned an MS in Exercise Physiology at Midwestern State University in Wichita Falls, TX and in 2003, she earned an MS in English Literature from ULM. She is a member of NSCAA and holds a USSF "A" License.

### AARON CLINE

#### ULM ASST. WOMEN'S COACH

Aaron Cline is beginning his fourth season as Assistant Coach of the ULM women's soccer team. Prior to joining the ULM staff, Cline spent five years with the Zionsville (Ind.) Youth Soccer Association, with the last three spent as Director of Coaching and Player Development. He also served as the head coach of the '94 Boys since 2003, while with this group, his team was promoted in classification three times. During the 2007 season, the Cline-led '94 Boys were Indiana State Challenge Cup Semifinalists.

A four-time letter winner as a midfielder, Cline earned a bachelor's degree in marketing from St. Joseph's College in Rensselaer, IN in May of 2003. He is a member of the NSCAA and holds a USSF "B" License and a National Youth License, as well as, a Level II Goalkeeping Diploma from the NSCAA.

### BRUCE DEATON LOUISIANA COLLEGE HEAD WOMEN'S COACH

Bruce Deaton is getting ready to start his second season as Head Coach of the Lady Wildcats soccer team. Prior to heading to Pineville, LA, he spent seven years as the head boys and girls coach at Ouachita Christian School. He played at Marshall University in Huntington, WV, where he earned both his bachelors and masters degrees. Coach Deaton was selected as the 2010 Division 3 LA High School Girls Coach of the Year. He is a member of the State of Louisiana Olympic Development Program coaching staff. He is a member of the NSCAA and holds a USSF "B" License and a National Youth License, as well as, an Advanced National Diploma and Level II Goalkeeping Diploma from the NSCAA.

Coach Lamb has worked hard to bring together a staff of top college and scholastic coaches, as well as, some of ULM's top collegiate players to assist the directors during the camp.
